According to Brevard S.O. this driver caused a vehicle accident in their jurisdiction and the driver fled. Sector 2 units responded to the area of the 528 and Dallas Boulevard to do an area check. While units responded, the Comm Center received a total of ten (10) 911 calls and generated seven (7) calls for service all related to the reckless silver Jeep Liberty. Several of the calls advised that the silver Jeep Liberty was all over the road, possibly drunk and caused several accidents to include a roll-over. As units responded to locate the separate crashes, Comm Center advised that on the 528 west of Dallas Boulevard, a roll-over crash was reported. The vehicle involved was a silver Jeep Liberty and according to FHP, the male driver was possibly armed with a gun and making threats. While responding to this crash (mile marker 23) in emergency mode, 321A, Deputy Derrick Smith was involved in a vehicle accident with an OCFR Battalion Chief on the 528 near mile marker 20. The Battalion Chief's vehicle sustained minor damage and the OCSO

						vehicle sustained significant damage thus requiring it to be towed.
