The Office of the State Attorney for the Ninth Judicial Circuit is responsible for reviewing all investigations into Officer Involved Critical Incidents (OICI) that occur in Orange and Osceola counties. On November 5, 2020, the Office of the State Attorney received all documents from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement detailing their complete investigation into an OICI by Orange County Sheriff's Office [REDACTED] against **SALAYTHIS MELVIN** on **August 7, 2020**.

I am writing to advise you that our review of this investigation is complete and that the Office of the State Attorney has determined that there has been no violation of Florida Law; and therefore our office will not be filing criminal charges against [REDACTED] for his use of force resulting in the death of Salaythis Melvin.

Attached please find the Office of the State Attorney's Office final report detailing our review of this OICI.
