
Dear Sheriff Mina,

The Office of the State Attorney for the Ninth Judicial Circuit is responsible for reviewing all investigations into Officer Involved Critical Incidents (OICI) that occur in Orange and Osceola counties. On December 15, 2021, the Office of the State Attorney received all documents from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement detailing their complete investigation into an OICI by Orange County Sheriff's Office [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] against **WILLIAM GUY SELLERS** on August 12, 2021.

I am writing to advise you that our review of this investigation is complete and that the Office of the State Attorney has determined that there has been no violation of Florida Law; and therefore our office will not be filing criminal charges against Deputies [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] or their use of force resulting in the death of William Guy Sellers.

Attached please find the Office of the State Attorney's Office final report detailing our review of this OICI.
