Question 1.

**What if there is multiple part number options, and multiple different prices, which is based off of VIN specifications?**

If multiple part number options are available based on VIN specifications, the vendor must ensure that the quoted part is appropriate for the specific vehicle configuration. For law enforcement vehicles, the quoted part must meet the requirements of the police package when applicable. If more than one part option is available, the vendor shall provide both options. The **first option** should be the manufacturer's primary recommended part number and price. The **second option** should be listed separately and identified as an alternate part number, including the manufacturer and corresponding price. All quoted parts must meet or exceed the vehicle manufacturer's specifications and any applicable police-package requirements.

Question 2.

**How do we load that in the Excel Spreadsheet?**

For the Excel spreadsheet:

- **Option 1** should be the manufacturer's primary recommended part number and corresponding price.
- If an alternate part number is available from manufacturer, the vendor may add an additional column and identify it as **Option 2 – Manufacturer**.
- Additional options may be included in separate columns, if necessary provided each option clearly identifies the manufacturer, part number, and price.
- All quoted parts must meet or exceed the vehicle manufacturer's specifications and any police-package requirements applicable to the vehicle.
